Capacities

Permission to sell merchandise must be sought in advance of the performance.
Blackheath Halls retains commission from merchandise sales of 30% + VAT of the gross takings if we sell merchandise

on behalf of the incoming promoter and provide the float. If you, as the incoming promoter, sell merchandise at the venue and provide your own float and staff, we retain 15% + VAT of gross takings.

We can arrange Programme Sellers, subject to commission.

Recordings and Filming
